4.4 Obtaining the title Grand Int. Champion or Grand Int. Premior

Provided the exhibit has obtained at least the minimum number of required points (\rightarrow § 6.9):

- CAGCIB is awarded in the International Champion class (class 5)
- CAGPIB is awarded in the International Premior class (class 6).

In order to obtain the title **Grand International Champion** or **Grand International Premior**, a cat must have been awarded CAGCIB respectively CAGPIB certificates at international FIFe shows in accordance with one of the following options:

Exceptions made for individual members residing in countries as outlined in Annexes 3 and 4.

Remarks

- A Option 2 automatically applies after obtaining the 5th CAGCIB respectively CAGPIB certificate in the same country
- B The certificates could be obtained in any country, even all in the same country
- Exception made for individual members residing in a location with just one place where shows are organised within a 400 km radius. These members can achieve all certificates for the title on shows organised within this radius
- D Option 3 automatically applies when option 2 is not fulfilled after obtaining 6 CAGCIB respectively CAGPIB certificates
- E A maximum of 7 CAGCIB respectively CAGPIB certificates could be obtained in the same country

4.5 Obtaining the title Supreme Champion or Supreme Premior

Provided the exhibit has obtained at least the minimum number of required points (\rightarrow § 6.9):

- CACS is awarded in the Grand International Champion class (class 3)
- CAPS is awarded in the Grand International Premior class (class 4).

In order to obtain the title **Supreme Champion** or **Supreme Premior**, a cat must have been awarded CACS respectively CAPS certificates at international FIFe shows in accordance with one of the following options:

Exceptions made for individual members residing in countries as outlined in Annexes 3 and 4.

Remarks

- A Option 2 automatically applies after obtaining the 8th CACS respectively CAPS certificate in the same country
- B The certificates could be obtained in any country, even all in the same country
- C Exception made for individual members residing in a location with just one place where shows are organised within a 400 km radius. These members can achieve all certificates for the title on shows organised within this radius
- D Option 3 automatically applies when option 2 is not fulfilled after obtaining 9 CACS respectively CAPS certificates
- E A maximum of 10 CACS respectively CAPS certificates could be obtained in the same country
